The new technology, known as SWIFT - which is an acronym for sustainable water initiative for tomorrow - would restore wastewater from sewers to drinking water standards and re-inject it deep into the ground to replenish the Potomac Aquifer, which spans from northern Virginia through Hampton Roads. The Virginia DEQ believes that current municipal withdrawals from the aquifer are approaching unsustainable levels.

**Help HBAV Support The Historic Stewart-Lee House**

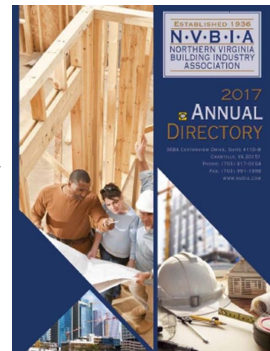

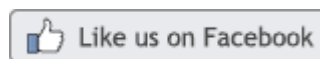
