A group of younger candidates is gathering in the wings, frustrated by crowded classrooms, traffic congestion and the rising cost of living in the county of 1.1 million - Virginia's most populous jurisdiction and its undisputed economic engine. Bulova, who has been on the board for 30 years, says she will announce next month whether she'll pursue a third term as chair. Supervisor Linda Q. Smyth, 69, has told friends that she is unsure whether she'll run, and Supervisor Catherine M. Hudgins, 74, declined through a spokeswoman to say whether she'll seek a fifth term.

Amazon says it will bring more than 25,000 full-time jobs and approximately \$2.5 billion in investment to Arlington with its new headquarters, which will include 4 million square feet of office space with the ability to expand to 8 million square feet. The company estimates its investment and job creation



will result in \$3.2 billion in incremental tax revenue over the next 20 years, and it will receive \$573 million in performance-based direct incentives from Arlington based on the creation of 25,000 jobs with an average wage of \$150,000.



[It's Going to Cost More to Use the Dulles Toll Road Starting in January](#)

Starting in January, it's going to cost you more to drive on the Dulles Toll Road under new toll rates approved by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. Rates at the main toll plaza will increase 75 cents per trip. Tolls at off-ramps will increase 50 cents. In all, most drivers will pay an additional \$1.25 for a one-way trip on the road (the main toll plaza + one ramp transaction). It is the first rate increase since 2014, and officials were quick to say they do not expect to increase rates again until 2023.

Amazon announced this week that it will bring 25,000 jobs and \$2.5 billion of investment into the Crystal City area of Arlington and portions of Alexandria. And just south in Prince William County, economic development leaders, noting other successes, say they're ready to capitalize on the region's new title as a national technology hub. Prince William is looking to attract five target industries, said Jeff Kaczmarek, the county's economic development director, including information technology, specialized logistics and supply chains, advanced manufacturing, life science and biotechnology, and federal agencies and corporate facilities.

Prince William County Public Schools is set to begin construction, possibly in the next few weeks, on a new middle school at Potomac Shores, with an opening date in 2021.

The county's school board awarded a \$52.4 million contract to Manassas-based V.F. Pavone Construction to build the new middle school, which will be the 17th in the school division.



[Potomac Nationals Finalize Deal for New Stadium in Fredericksburg](#)

The Fredericksburg City Council voted unanimously Tuesday to seal the deal on a new stadium for the Potomac Nationals, meaning the minor league baseball team that has called Prince William County home since 1984 will move 35 miles south in time for opening day 2020. The agreement calls for the team to finance, build and maintain the 5,000-seat stadium. The City of Fredericksburg will be considered an "anchor tenant" and will contribute \$1.05 million annually to the team for 30 years.


