[Phase 2 of Lorton Prison Redevelopment to Begin this Month as Southern Fairfax County's Pipeline Grows](#)

Fairfax County is partnering with Elm Street Development and The Alexander Co. on the \$188M redevelopment of an 80-acre portion of the Lorton Reformatory, a prison that operated from 1910 to 2001 and has since been named a historic landmark. The development team last year delivered the first phase of the project, dubbed Liberty, which included 165 rental apartments in renovated prison dorms on the minimum-security portion of the prison complex. It also added 83 new, for-sale townhouses and 24 single-family homes.

Three big-name developers are partnering to build the "Midline," a mixed-use project with 1.8 million square feet of development near the Wiehle-Reston East Metro Station. If approved, the project by JBG, EYA and Chevy Chase Land Co. would bring 1.2 million square feet of residential development, a senior living center, 260,000 square feet of office and up to 250,000 square feet of retail to 17.5 acres east of Wiehle Avenue, south of Sunset Hills Road, and west of Michael Faraday Drive.

They each saw year-over-year declines, but Arlington's was smaller and, as a result, the county posted the largest average per-square-foot price for real estate across Northern Virginia in August, while Fairfax County posted an increase for the month. At an average of \$456 per square foot, Arlington was down 3.4 percent from \$472 a year before, but Falls Church (which had seen a per-square-foot cost of \$530 in August 2017) was down 18.3 percent to \$433 and second place in the new ranking.

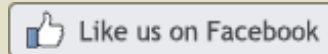
